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Product Summary

This release bulletin provides late-breaking information about the Sybase® Aleri Adapter for Replication Server® 2.0. A more recent version may be available on the Web.

Known Issues

CR #	Description
N/A	Primary keys cannot be updated.
N/A	Sybase Aleri Streaming Platform element names must match column names. Mapping of table to stream works, but we do not currently look at the column to element map.
N/A	If there are two different RepDefs that define the same owner.objectname , the columns from both will show up in one discovered table.
N/A	Sybase Aleri Streaming Platform default logging levels will hide some issues that can stop the adapter from running. The most noticeable one is the Sybase Aleri Streaming Platform will not run unless all streams have primary keys defined. This includes the "warning message" that displays the problem. If you are having problems running, change the Debug Level to 4 within the Startup Options of the model.
651345	A model can listen on 2 TDS ports, but cannot distribute data from 2 DataLocations into one Stream.
658983	The "truncate table" command is not supported.
657734	TIME values inserted in a stream are displayed with an offset to GMT.
657382	The StreamViewer displays large money data values in scientific notation. This also affects output files created using "Save Data" from the StreamViewer. For example, "100000000.0000" converts to "1.0E8" and "922337203685477.5807" converts to "9.223372036854776E14". This is a viewer issue. When you create an output connection and write the values to a CSV file, the values appear fine.
649796	Per Stream Properties always use default settings.
646154	Need to create the Replication Server connection and subscriptions prior to creating the Aleri DataLocation because the DataLocation needs the connection info and subscriptions to exist before it can do Discovery. But the Replication Server connection will not come up until the Aleri DataLocation and table Stream is started. Until the connection comes UP, the subscriptions will not be VALID.
650201	Updates to a key field are supported only under certain very specific conditions.
650142	The autogen parameter must be set to true for streams handling stored procedures or they will not update properly.
648035	The rs_lastcommit should always be configured to be persisted and all models using the same RSAleriAdapter RS connection should be forced to utilize a common rs_lastcommit persistent file, otherwise there will be problems at startup.
648866	Dematerialization of subscriptions is not supported.
649672	The MONEY type of the Sybase Aleri Streaming Platform Pub/Sub API does not accept java.math.BigDecimal.

CR #	Description
648206	The adapter does not support bulk inserts from the Replication Server.
651192	Minimal columns is not supported: it should be off at both the red def and connection level.
648046	SSL is not implemented in the adapter.
648605	The adapter only supports two authentication methods: "none" and "pam". It does not support "rsa" or "gssapi".
648207	The adapter does not support dynamic inserts from the Replication Server.
646871	Transactions are not guaranteed to be consistent across streams.
648609	Table, column and stored procedure names may not contain spaces, SQL keywords, or delimited identifiers. Any names that contain these characters must be changed in the subscription.
650493	Not all Replication Server configuration parameters can be left set to their defaults. [NEED LIST AND VALUES]
652043	The StreamViewer displays the character string "null" as "NULL" while the console shows the value as lower case. This conversion affects data saved from the StreamViewer also.
648794	The "Admin User" name (default aarsAdminUser), specified in the Advanced property tab for the connector, must be unique to distinguish incoming RepServer TDS connections from "Admin User" connections. If the "Admin User" matches the login name from RepServer, "SQL Command denied for Admin User" errors will be returned to the log and/or TDS client.
